



- Christ comes for His saints.
- Saints are translated and go to heaven.
- The world is unchanged and unjudged and continues to sin.

“As presented in the New Testament, no unfulfilled prophecy is given as standing between the church and the time of its rapture.”

p. 80, Major Bible Themes, Chafer and Walvoord

- This means the rapture is next, close, and imminent.
